“Canoe Coaching Clinic for Scouters” 2026

Purpose: to introduce Scouters to personal canoeing. This activity will not prepare Scouters for a leadership role in canoeing. Specifically this introductory canoeing activity will not prepare Scouters to take youth on a day or part day of canoeing or on a canoe trip. A recognized, provincially certified canoe course is highly recommended for the above type of activity.

Participant Prerequisite: must be able to confidently swim 100m (4 lengths of most municipal pools). There will not be a swim test for this event. Swimming ability must be self-assessed by the participants.
